

Frequently Asked Questions

Are Fresh Produce Distributions safe during COVID-19?

All participants, staff and volunteers will be wearing face masks during the event. We will have everyone spaced 6 feet apart to make sure people can be safe. All staff and volunteers are either vaccinated or have 48 hour negative COVID-19 test.

What can I expect to receive at a Fresh Produce Distribution?

You can expect around 50 pounds of fresh produce of 3-4 varieties, depending on the location.

What kind of produce will I get?

You will get a variety of bulk produce that changes every distribution.

How many times can I go to a Fresh Produce Distribution?

You can go to as many Fresh Produce Distributions as you want!

What time should I come to a Fresh Produce Distribution?

We ask that you not come earlier than 30 minutes before the event time. If you arrive earlier than 30 minutes before, you will not be able to line up and reserve your spot early- we will ask you to wait somewhere else. This helps us manage lines and make sure that people do not have to wait a long time to receive produce.

What do I need to bring?

ID is not required at the event. If you have a cell phone, please bring it for online registration. If you are walking, bring your own carts and bags if you have them.

How do I sign up or register for Fresh Produce Distributions?

Pre-registration is not required. You will register at the event.

Can I volunteer at the event?

You are not required to volunteer to get produce!
